
The NCE router/modem unit is pre programmed, ready to use and you only require a data SIM card to get started. The unit is not network locked so feel free to find the best data deal with any carrier and on any plan, prepaid etc. To connect your modem to your Tablet, phone or computer, go to the settings menu on your device click the wifi icon and search for devices, select the NCE icon enter the password 123456 then click connect. Once connected you are ready to use the internet on your device. It is advised you change the WIFI password so other cannot connect to your wifi network unless authorized to do so.

Installation

- Find a suitable position inside the van, ie a cardboard that is secure and dry to install your main module.
- Remove the security cover by sliding forward to expose the main module.



- Either use double sided tape or 4 small screws to mount the module cradle securely.
- Mount your 3 external antennas on the roof (see fig below for optimal positions)



 Mount the internal wifi antenna in a high area free from obstacles.



 Connect the power wires ensuring correct polarity.




7. Insert a small pin to eject the SIM cradle.



8. Insert your sim card onto the SIM cradle and reinstall the cradle.





 Plug in the power cable and the antennas into the appropriate positions as indicated below.




Connect WIFI antennas

- d. Click on the edit icon. (see fig 1d)
- e. Click on the key box, enter your new password then press "save and apply" (see fig 1d)
- f. Once this is done the unit will reset, wait approximately 30 seconds for the restart, once the device had restarted go to settings on you device, turn on wifi, search for devices, select NCE click connect, insert the new password.

Changing WIFI password

- a. Type 192.168.1.1 into your search engine on your device. (see fig 1a)
- b. Use "root" as the username and "admin" as the password. (see fig 1b)
- c. Click on Network then Wifi. (see fig 1c)
